THOUGHTS TO PONDER

The very word CONFIRMATION means to CONFIRM, in this case, to CONFIRM one's FAITH.

If there is no faith, there is nothing to confirm.

In the Book of James, we are told,

"Faith without works is useless."

Attend Mass EVERY Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation.

Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) REGULARLY.

Receive the Sacrament of Holy Communion REGULARLY.

REQUIREMENTS TO RECEIVE CONFIRMATION

"To receive confirmation licitly outside the danger of death requires that a person who has the use of reason be suitably instructed, properly disposed, and able to renew the baptismal promise." (Canon 882)

REQUIREMENTS TO BE A CONFIRMATION SPONSOR

"...16 years old, confirmed, and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on and cannot be the father or the mother of the one to be confirmed." (Canon 879)

"...the sponsor is to take care that the confirmed persons behaves as a true witness of Christ and faith and fulfills the obligations inherent with the sacrament" (Canon 892)

**THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS FOR CANDIDATES AND SPONSORS
WOULD INCLUDE ATTENDING MASS AND THE SACRAMENTS
ON A REGULAR BASIS**

**AND FURTHER THAT THE INDIVIDUAL BE IN
GOOD STANDING IN THE CHURCH.**

(This EXCLUDES anyone currently in an invalid marriage.)
